News from Haiti

Craig Bogard, founder and leader of Aslan Youth Ministries in Red Bank, New Jersey, was our last connection to Ouanaminthe, Haiti. He has plans to build several facilities on land Aslan has purchased just outside Ouanaminthe. In the meantime, however, he has been encouraging people with medical training to volunteer to come to Haiti to help for short periods of time. There is a hospital in Fort Liberte which is 10 miles from Ouanaminthe. Since the hospitals in Port au Prince and Cap Haitien are full, patients have been transferred to the facility in Fort Liberte. Craig has met with the mayor of Fort Liberte, to offer help at that site. See www.aslanyouth.org for periodic updates on this area of Haiti which has held our interest over the past 40 years.
